

## **TPC Campfire Ring Quality Statement**

TPC Campfire Rings have been manufactured under the highest standards of quality and are to be free from defects in material and workmanship. However, logos and images are cut into the sides of our campfire rings using a CNC plasma cutter and the finished product is 100% hand welded and hand finished. Logos and letters cut into the sides of our campfire rings are cut in fine detail, with tolerances up to 1/32" (.030 inches). As such, slight variations in finish as well as resolution and detail of artwork, and/or custom logos or custom designed artwork are normal, and may vary due to the nature of our manufacturing process. Variations include but are not limited to logo, image, or text placement, size of logo, image or text, quality (thickness, resolution) of line art, cut and weld penetration, and uniformity. TPC Products are painted using high temperature paint. Every effort will be made to protect your new TPC campfire ring from the elements, but because of the nature of the steel used in the fabrication, slight blemishes, marks, stains, flaws or imperfections in the steel may be visible through the paint. Over time your TPC campfire ring may appear rusty, flaky, dusty, gritty or dirty and may rub on your hands or clothing if touched. It may also leave rust marks on the hard surface it is placed on. We therefore recommend placing on a non-flammable pad, cement pavers, bricks, or a large piece of flagstone under the campfire ring for added protection.

TPC Campfire rings can be refurbished by simply cleaning the inside and outside of the ring with a wire brush and recoating with high temperature black paint. Multiple coats may be necessary to completely cover a refurbished ring.
